Previous meeting minutes not read

Community Council Vice President Elizabeth Williams called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Cop of the Month First Precinct & Cop of The Month Transit District 2, for June, July, August, September and October will be announced in a small celebration on November 17th at Tribeca Kitchen.

First Precinct Deputy Inspector Iocco Report:

Crime statistics read are based on current 28-day period compared to the same 28-day period last year.

Overall crime decreased by 19 % with 97 crimes vs 1220 for the 28-day period.

Rape: There was no rape reported in the 28-day period vs 1 the same as last year.

Robberies for the week remained the same at 5 vs. the same for the 28 period.

Felony assaults decreased by 50 % with 5 reported vs 10 the same for the 28-day period.

Burglaries decreased by 66 % with 3 versus 9 for the same 28-day period.

Grand Larcenies decreased by 50 % with 1 vs 2 for the same 28-day period.

GLAs decreased slightly for the 28-day period, with 2 grand larcenies compared to 3 in the last 28-day period.

Transit District 2:

Detective James Rudolph announced that there will be an event at TD2 on November 17th from 1-4 p.m. at the headquarters to support our troops; all are welcomed.
